Indian Institute of Packaging

Indian Institute of Packaging (IIP) is a national apex body which was set up in 1966 by the packaging and allied industries and the Ministry of Commerce, Government of India, with the specific objective of improving the packaging standards in the country. The Institute is an autonomous body working under the administrative control of the Ministry of Commerce. The Institute endeavors to improve the standards of packaging needed for the promotion of exports and create infrastructural facilities for overall packaging improvement in India. The diversified activities of the Institute encompasses the entire spectrum of packaging which includes research and development, education, training, testing, information, consultancy, exhibition, designs, publication, library and database services. The Institute is having its Head Quarter at Mumbai and branches located at Delhi, Kolkata, Ahmedabad, Hyderabad and Chennai. Upcoming centres at Guwahati, Bangaluru and Kakinanda are in the process of establishment.

World Packaging Organization (WPO)

The World Packaging Organization (WPO) is a non profit, non governmental, International Federation of National Packaging Institute, and associations, Regional Packaging Federations and other interested parties including individuals, corporations and trade associations. Founded on 6th September, 1968 at Tokyo by visionary leaders from the global packaging community. The Asian Packaging Federation (APF), a non profit organization established in Tokyo, Japan in 1967. It unites the packaging interests of all trades and industries in the Asia Pacific Region and beyond under cooperative umbrella. The APF Secretariat rotates amongst the member countries and is currently hosted by the Indian Institute of Packaging.

Asian Packaging Congress (APC)

In the recent days, it is observed that few of the major socio economic factors like globalization, liberalization, increase of literacy resulting into the increasing of health consciousness, increase of purchasing power capacity due to increase of dual income group, consumerism, increase of more working women leads to increase of demand for ready to eat food, booming of retail market etc., have caused to gear up the increase of demand for the consumption of packaging materials. This has led to increase the production capacity by considering the innovation processing technology and also to develop the efficient packaging materials in terms of enhanced mechanical properties, barrier properties, optical properties and thus to upgrade the functional properties of packaging materials to meet the requirements of the international market.

The main objective of the two days Asian Packaging Congress is to highlight the latest trends and technologies of various packaging materials, conversion technologies, packaging machineries with automation to increase the productivity and to reduce the wastage and also to meet the requirement of the packaging user industry to satisfy the demands of modern consumers. The various topics will be covered by the galaxy of speakers from India and overseas who would deliver the presentations around the theme

Theme of APC - Packaging : 3S (Safe Secure Sustainable)

The theme of the Conference is "Packaging: 3S (Safe Secure Sustainable). The theme was chosen by considering the fact that the packaging plays a vital role in the growth of economy of the country. The economic growth of the country is largely affected by the packaging industry in terms of high volume of production of packaging raw materials, its conversion into different forms of packaging and the usage of different forms of packaging by the user industries with the help of innovative packaging machinery. Considering this aspect, this particular theme is found to be more appropriate in the today's context.

It is also proposed to organize Research Conclave as per parallel session concurrently. The main objective of the Research Conclave is to encourage the young students & researchers from the universities who are involved into packaging research.

It is believed that the Research Conclave would enable to attract the young scientists from India as well as overseas universities to make research paper presentation. 2. Poster Session

It is also planned to have a Poster Session on Research Papers where the students from different universities and also from the colleges involved to food technology, polymer technology, printing technology, packaging design etc., will be participating by displaying the posters.
